Bible-Centered Christian Education

Guide for Pastors, Small Group Leaders, Sunday School Teachers, and Christians wanting to know their Bibles

This 365 Day Bible Reading plan is the basis for the universal Christian education program in our church. Since our church is a life-giving Bible-based gathering of believers, we encourage our teachers to teach the Scriptures in a life-giving way. This guide goes through the highlights of the Bible in the course of a year. It excludes material that is repetitive or that might not be immediately relevant to most students of the Bible. It does, though, include pertinent stories, biblical principles, central theological truths, and texts that provide pragmatic guidance.

We encourage teachers and students to read the Bible passage for the day of their class and study the material until they know the primary messages, its context and practical application. If there are other classes going on the same day within our church family, they may be studying the same text albeit taught age-appropriately and according to the distinctives of the group. So family members as well as fellow church members are able to discuss the same material.

None of our instructors are required to teach according to this schedule. This is a guideline. Leaders are free to teach Christian books or other biblical lessons that are meaningful to them and their class, as long as they are approved by the pastor's office or the pastor of small groups. Some classes are based on a specific subject, like healing, so they would not follow this schedule. Other groups are task oriented, so they may not follow this schedule. But we do encourage all ongoing classes to seriously consider using this schedule to provide continuity within our church. We provide this guideline so those who attend our church will develop a comprehensive knowledge of the Bible and its modern application.

Whether you use this as a teaching guide for harmonious Christian education or as a personal Bible reading plan, we encourage you to use this practical guide in your growth in the Scriptures.

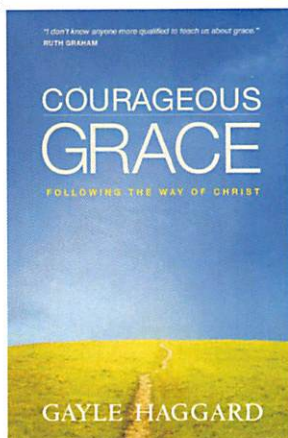
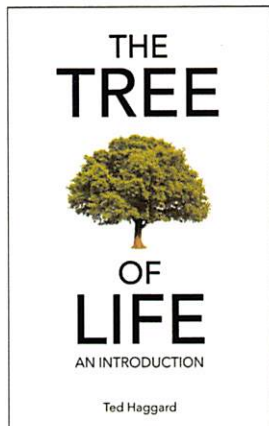
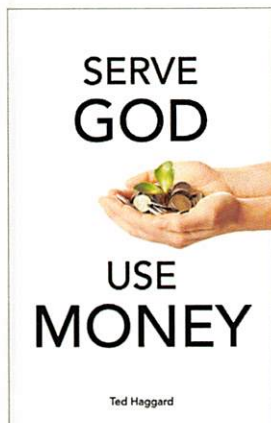
